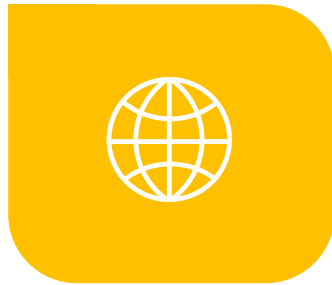

Approximate timelines	Proposed actions
30 May 2022	Dissemination of the questionnaire
30 June 2022	Deadline for input
July to September 2022	Processing of information
Q4 2022	One-time publication
Q4 2022 – Q1 2023	Development and publication of the civil society component on the platform
