

Who is Who in International Protection Platform

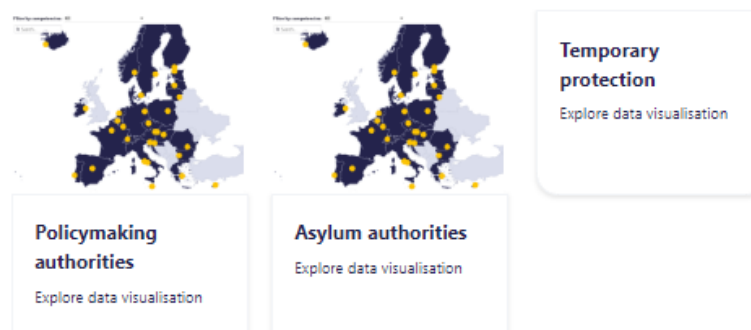
The [Who is Who in International Protection](#) platform contains interactive maps which map key stakeholders involved in various stages of asylum and reception systems.



The platform presents the roles and responsibilities of key actors involved in international protection in each EU+ country, in addition to their mandates as defined by national policies and legislation. The interlinks between different authorities and institutions are also outlined.

The Who is Who platform is regularly updated with new topics and data visualisations. Some thematic overviews have accompanying reports available in PDF.

Information is gathered through desk research based on publicly-available sources and EUAA reports. Entries are validated by Member States and other stakeholders, if required, for example the EUAA Consultative Forum for information from civil society organisations.
