

Curriculum vitae of Mark CAMILLERI, Acting Head of Institutional and Horizontal Affairs Centre (C4)

Mark Camilleri is the acting Head of the Institutional and Horizontal Affairs Centre responsible for providing horizontal services, governance, business and legal support to the Management Board, the Executive Director, functions and centres, ensuring the security of staff, information and assets, managing internal and external communication, public relations and events, and coordinating the Agency's cooperation activities at European and international level.

Mr. Camilleri has been involved in the EUAA (previously EASO) since its inception in 2010 and has occupied various management and senior positions within the Agency. Before joining EASO, Mr. Camilleri occupied various positions at the European Commission, including within the Asylum Unit in DG Home Affairs, where he was responsible for coordinating various practical cooperation measures including the EURASIL network and the setting up EASO. Mr. Camilleri also occupied the post of International Relations and Enlargement Coordinator both within DG Home Affairs and DG Justice, and the post of Interinstitutional Coordinator within DG JLS. Prior to joining the European Commission, Mr. Camilleri worked at the Office of the Prime Minister as EU Programme Manager.
