Proposals received from the pre-selected applicant(s) that are not compliant and/or do not observe the area of research and/or the surface area sought as mentioned in point 3 of this notice, will be discarded. Applicants of premises excluded will be duly informed.

Eligible proposals will be analysed based on quality and price criteria in accordance with the following weightings:

- price (40 %),
- quality (60 %).

The tender's quality (Q) will be determined based on the following elements (100 points):

- geographical location in relation to the building occupied by the Cypriot Asylum Service (please refer to Section 3.1., first paragraph): 55 points (minimum required: 27.5),
- suitability of the proposed premises vis a vis the requirements stated under Section 3.1, effectiveness of the surface areas proposed and distribution of space in the premises: 30 points (minimum required: 15),
- security, safety and business continuity measures in the premises in addition to the minimum requirements indicated under point 3.1 (i.e. presence of security guards, installation of fire extinguishers, emergency exits and evacuation plans, existence of emergency power generator, etc.): 15 points (minimum required: 7.5).

The classification of the offers will be based on a final score (F) in accordance with the following formula:

$$F = (60 \% \times Q) + (40 \% \times P)$$
