EUAA/2022/020 – Framework service contract for the Fixed telephony services for EUAA

I. Description of the services:

The European Union Agency for Asylum (the EUAA) is planning to purchase high quality and cost effective fixed telecommunication services for EUAA .

More in detail, the requested services will include:

- Provision of a SIP trunk compatible with Ribbon Session Border Controller Software Edition Edge (SBC SWe Edge)
- Minimum of 30 simultaneous inbound or outbound phone calls/channels per location
- Local toll-free numbers, at a maximum of two per country, with a minimum of 20 simultaneous inbound or outbound calls per number
- Possibility of having service in any EU Member-state
- Migration from currently used fixed line solution to the proposed one
- Service availability at minimum for 99% of the month
- Hotline and helpdesk in English
- Incident response and resolution

II. Description of the contract

The EUAA envisages awarding a framework services contract. The maximum estimated duration of the contract will be 48 months. The estimated total value for the whole framework contract duration is €139,500.00

III. Description of the procurement procedure

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of the negotiated procurement procedure with at least 5 economic operators through which the EUAA may award the above-mentioned contract.¹

This ex-ante publicity has an indicative value and is in no way binding on the EUAA. The EUAA may decide not to launch the procurement procedure without candidates being entitled to claim any compensation.

Only candidates invited by the contracting authority to take part in the procedure concerned can submit a tender.
