Provision of fuel and car washing services for EUAA in Romania

I. Description of the supplies

The European Union Agency for Asylum (the EUAA) is planning to purchase for the provision of fuel and car washing services for its staff members and members of personnel deployed to Bucharest and in the rest of the territory of Romania.

More in detail, the requested supplies will include:

- **Fuel:**
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 - **Euro Diesel**, quality conforming to the standard EN 590:2009 or equivalent;
 - **Euro Super/Unleaded (95 octane)**, quality conforming to the standard EN 228:2008 or equivalent
- **Fuel cards or devices:**

The fuel cards or devices shall facilitate the supply of fuel and car washing services, with no cash payment involved.
- **Car washing services:**
 - Exterior car wash;
 - Combined exterior car wash and interior cleaning

II. Description of the contract

The EUAA envisages awarding a Framework Supply Contract. The maximum estimated duration of the contract will be maximum 48 months. The estimated total value for the whole framework contract duration is € 60,000.00.

III. Description of the procurement procedure





This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of the negotiated procurement procedure with at least 3 economic operators through which the EUAA may award the above-mentioned contract.¹

This ex-ante publicity has an indicative value and is in no way binding on the EUAA. The EUAA may decide not to launch the procurement procedure without candidates being entitled to claim any compensation.

Only candidates invited by the contracting authority to take part in the procedure concerned can submit a tender.
