Provision of data visualizations

I. Description of the services

The European Union Agency for Asylum (the EUAA) is planning to purchase data visualizations. More in detail, the requested services/supplies will include:

- Data visualisation conceptualisation: Based on an analytical report provided by EUAA,
 the service provider shall prepare a mock-up set of data visualisations or data story
 presenting its key findings;
- Data visualisation development in Flourish: The service provider will develop the data visualisations and/or data story using Flourish, based on the mock-up made in step 1 or following the EUAA own requirements/mock-up;
- Transfer of knowledge through training: Train EUAA staff on updating and replicating the data visualisations and stories developed under step 2;
- Transfer of knowledge through documentation: Documentation describing how the different data visualisations and data stories were developed (including scripts and coding used, if relevant) is produced.

II. Description of the contract

The EUAA envisages awarding a single framework contract. The maximum estimated duration of the contract will be 24 months including one possible renewal. The estimated total value for the whole framework contract duration is €60,000.00 EUR.

III. Description of the procurement procedure

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of the negotiated procurement procedure with at least 3 economic operators through which the EUAA may award the above-mentioned contract.

This ex-ante publicity has an indicative value and is in no way binding on the EUAA. The EUAA may decide not to launch the procurement procedure without candidates being entitled to claim any compensation.

Only candidates invited by the contracting authority to take part in the procedure concerned can submit a tender.
